

His hearty laugh and the ability to solicit laughter from others will be greatly missed. As a proud man, Les always had an explanation of hope for the day's concern or problem. His inspiration of hope comes from his love and acceptance of his Savior Jesus Christ.

On Thursday, August 11, 1988 at 11:00 P.M., Leslie James Timmons departed this life.
